**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to the STEM advisory council.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 218 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 official edition, is hereby amended in subsection (c) by striking out the word “30” in the first
3 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following word:- 35.

4 SECTION 2. Said section 218 is hereby further amended in subsection (c) by inserting
5 after the words “not-for-profit organization” the following words:- ; provided further, that not
6 fewer than 12 members of the Council shall represent companies that employ STEM
7 professionals.
