An Act relative to transit.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 23A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 official edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection:-

3           (i) to coordinate with the MBTA and the regional transit authorities to insure transit  
4 services are available to employees of existing and expanding businesses throughout the  
5 Commonwealth.
