An Act relative to farmers' markets.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 128 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 1A the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 1B. "Farmers Market" shall mean a public market or public market place located  
4 in a city or town that operates or occurs more than once per year for the primary purpose for  
5 Massachusetts farmers, from more than 1 farm, to vend food, crops and other farm related items  
6 that they have produced directly to the public.

7 A public market or public market place used by farmers that is established by a  
8 municipality under section 10 of chapter 40, or operates on department of conservation and  
9 recreation land by special permit under section 2F of chapter 132A, shall be deemed under this  
10 definition as a "Farmers Market".
