An Act relative to underground storage tanks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 21O of the general laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after subsection (4) the following:

3           a)     Any such corrective action may include but is not limited to financial  
4 reimbursement to the owners of a negatively impacted property who have sustained assessable  
5 financial damage due to negligent release;

6           SECTION 2. This legislation shall pertain to any and all properties undergoing  
7 remediation through the 21J fund at the time of enactment.
