An Act to amend the lead law to include water piping.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Section 197A of Chapter 111 of General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by amending lines 2, 83, and 84 to add “, plumbing and  
3 water piping,” after “plaster” and amending line 35 to add “plumbing and water piping,” after  
4 “plaster, ”.
