An Act relative to underground storage tank remediation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the General or Special Laws or  
2   Administrative Regulations, citizens of the Commonwealth subject to damage caused by the  
3   release of petroleum from an underground storage tank shall be eligible to recover funds  
4   remediating personal and legal expenses and loss of property value. Said funds shall be  
5   recovered with proof of assessable financial damage and shall not be subject to the requirement  
6   of the judgment of a court of law. Said funds shall be paid from the fund enumerated in Mass  
7   General Laws Chapter 21J.

8           SECTION 2. This legislation shall pertain to any and all properties undergoing  
9   remediation through the 21J fund at the time of enactment.
