An Act relative to Lottery compliance investigations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 31 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 3, after the words “any member or  
3 employee of the commission" the following words:- except as authorized by the director for  
4 investigative purposes,

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2019.
