An Act establishing civil penalties for littering from a motor vehicle.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 22G the
2 following section:-

3 Section 22G1/2. No operator of a motor vehicle shall litter, or knowingly permit an
4 occupant of their vehicle to litter, public or private property through the disposal of trash or
5 garbage from said motor vehicle. A violation of this section shall be considered a civil motor
6 vehicle infraction and shall be punishable by a civil citation issued pursuant to chapter 90C
7 which shall include fine of \$100 for a first offense, \$250 for a second offense, and \$500 for a
8 third or subsequent offense. A civil citation issued pursuant to this section shall not be a
9 surchargeable offense under section 113B of chapter 175
