By Mr. Dooley of Norfolk, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4353) of Shawn Dooley and Richard J. Ross (by vote of the town) that the town of Plainville be authorized to grant additional 6 additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises, 3 additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises and 5 additional licenses for the sale of wines and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises. **In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)**

An Act authorizing the town of Plainville to grant additional licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2   licensing authority of the town of Plainville may grant 6 additional licenses for the sale of all  
3   alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 12 of said chapter 138. The  
4   licenses shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

5           (b) Notwithstanding said section 17 of said chapter 138, the licensing authority of the  
6   town of Plainville may grant 3 additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be  
7   drunk on the premises pursuant to section 15 of said chapter 138. The licenses shall be subject to  
8   all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

9           (c) Notwithstanding said section 17 of said chapter 138, the licensing authority of the  
10   town of Plainville may grant 5 additional licenses for the sale of wines and malt beverages not to

- 11 be drunk on the premises pursuant to said section 15 of said chapter 138. The licenses shall be
- 12 subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.
