3           SECTION 1. Section 102 by inserting at the end of paragraph (c), in line 1810 after the  
4 term “176G”, the following new language:-

5           The commissioner shall also exempt carriers from complying with this section based on  
6 (i) whether the majority of a carrier’s chapter 176J membership is enrolled in a single rate  
7 region; or (ii) whether the majority of the carrier’s chapter 176J membership is enrolled in  
8 subsidized coverage offered under chapter 176Q through which such members receive state or  
9 federal subsidies; or (iii) whether the carrier receives 80 per cent or more of its income from  
10 government programs, including subsidized coverage offered under chapter 176Q through which  
11 such members receive state or federal subsidies.
