An Act authorizing the Somerville Retirement Board to divest from fossil fuel companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Somerville  
2 Retirement Board (hereinafter referred to as SRB) may, in accordance with the procurement  
3 process described in Chapter 32, section 23B of the General Laws, divest in whole or in part  
4 from any investment in fossil fuel companies. In accordance with this provision, the SRB may,  
5 after following said procurement process, invest in index funds or other investment vehicles that  
6 may not include fossil fuel companies. For the purposes of this section, fossil fuel companies  
7 shall be defined as a company identified by a Global Industry Classification System code in one  
8 of the following sectors: (1) coal and consumable fuels; (2) integrated oil and gas; (3) oil and gas  
9 exploration and production.

10           Section 2: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
