By Representative Pignatelli of Lenox and Senator Hinds, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4443) of Smitty Pignatelli and Adam G. Hinds (by vote of the town) that the town of Otis be authorized to grant one additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk off the premises in said town. Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure. [Local Approval Received.]

### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to the sale of alcoholic beverages in the town of Otis.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Notwithstanding Section 17 of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 138,

- 2 the local licensing authority of the Town of Otis may grant one additional license for the sale of
- 3 all alcoholic beverages to be drunk off the premises, pursuant to Section 15, Chapter 138, to
- 4 Papa's Healthy Food and Fuel, East Otis, Massachusetts. The license shall be subject to all of
- 5 said Chapter 138 except said section 17.

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The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other location

but it may grant the license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files with the

licensing authority a letter from the department of revenue and a letter from the department of

unemployment assistance indicating the license is in good standing with those departments and

that all applicable taxes, fees and contributions have been paid.

If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use at the location of original issuance, it shall be returned physically with all legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto to the licensing authority which may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same location under the same conditions as specified in this act.

SECTION 2: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
