The committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure, to whom was referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 135) of Daniel Cahill relative to the conducting of an online lottery by the State Lottery Commission; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 157) of Carmine L. Gentile and others relative to the protection of personal identity; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2813) of James M. Cantwell and others relative to the security of personal financial information; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2814) of James M. Cantwell and others relative to amending certain statutes pertaining to data security breaches and calling for an investigation by a special commission (including members of the General Court) on cybersecurity to assess the various threats across the Commonwealth; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2815) of Nick Collins and others relative to the licensing of refrigeration technicians working on residential or light commercial refrigeration systems; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2827) of William M. 1           *Ordered,* That the committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure be  
2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of  
3 House documents numbered 135, 157, 2813, 2814, 2815 and 2827, relative to economic  
4 development study matters.

5           Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study  
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
8 on or before December 31, 2018.
