**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to data.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, are hereby
2 amended by adding after chapter 93K the following chapter:-

3 Chapter 93L.

4 Section 1. Individually identifiable customer proprietary network information, including
5 but not limited to website browsing history and application usage, derived from a customer's use
6 of an internet access service, whether by wire or radio, shall not be used to determine: (i) a
7 Massachusetts resident's credit or insurance rating; (ii) the interest rate applicable to a loan or
8 other credit facility issued to a Massachusetts resident; or (iii) the insurance policy premium to
9 be paid on an insurance policy issued to a Massachusetts resident.

10 Section 2. A violation of any of the provisions of this chapter shall constitute a violation
11 of chapter 93A.
