The committee on Financial Services, to whom were referred so much of the recommendations of the Department of the State Treasurer (House, No. 23) as relates to life insurance proceeds (House, No. 34); so much of the recommendations of the Department of the State Treasurer (House, No. 23) as relates to enhancing customer protection with respect to unclaimed property (House, No. 35); the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 494) of Antonio F. D. Cabral and others relative to the labor rates paid by insurance companies to motor vehicle repair shops; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 546) of Louis L. Kafka and others for legislation to authorize the Commissioner of the Division of Insurance to set labor rates paid by insurance companies to auto repairers; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2965) of John J. Lawn, Jr., John W. Scibak and Timothy R. Whelan for an investigation by the commissioner of insurance of the labor rates paid by motor vehicle insurers for the repair of damaged motor vehicles, reports recommending the accompanying order (House, No. 4785) ought to be adopted.
