An Act regarding a qualified apprentice tax credit.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to regulate a certain tax credit, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (v) of said section 6 of said chapter 62, added by section 14 of  
2 chapter 228 of the acts of 2018, is hereby repealed.

3           SECTION 2. Section 38HH of said chapter 63, added by section 17 of chapter 228 of the  
4 acts of 2018, is hereby repealed.

5           SECTION 3. Sections 1 and 2 shall take effect on January 1, 2022.
