**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for John Taylor Woodward, an employee of the Hampshire County Sheriff's Department.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Hampshire County  
2 Sheriff's Department shall establish a sick leave bank for John Taylor Woodward, an employee  
3 of the Hampshire County Community Corrections Center. Any employee of the department may  
4 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by  
5 John Taylor Woodward. If John Taylor Woodward terminates employment with the department  
6 or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be  
7 transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for  
8 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave  
9 bank as determined by the department.
