**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to election locations for fire district number 2 in the town of South Hadley.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the prudential
2 committee of fire district number 2 in the town of South Hadley may designate a polling place
3 outside the geographical boundaries of fire district number 2 for the annual district election;
4 provided, that the location is within the town of South Hadley.

5 SECTION 2. The prudential committee of fire district number 2 in the town of South
6 Hadley shall designate the date and polling place for the annual district election at least 20 days
7 before the election. If the location of a polling place for the annual district election is changed,
8 the prudential committee of the district shall post printed descriptions of the polling place and
9 may give further notice thereof as the prudential committee may determine.

10 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
