An Act relative to placing a plaque at the McCarthy Pavilion in the city of Revere in honor of Grace Hill Sannella.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           A plaque shall be installed at the northeast corner of the McCarthy Pavillion in the city of  
2 Revere in honor of Grace Hill Sannella, for her forty-two years of faithful service to the citizens  
3 of Revere and an affectionate advocate of Revere Beach. The department of conservation and  
4 recreation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with  
5 the standards of the department and shall read:

6           “Her time is forever, everywhere is her place”

7           “November 22, 1939 – June 3, 2018”
