**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for John S. Gay, an employee of the Trial Court of the Commonwealth.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Trial Court of the Commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the trial court of the  
2 commonwealth shall establish a sick leave bank for John S. Gay, an employee of the Springfield  
3 district court in the trial court of the commonwealth. Any employee of the trial court of the  
4 commonwealth may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick  
5 leave bank for use by John S. Gay. If John S. Gay terminates employment with the trial court of  
6 the commonwealth or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick  
7 leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not  
8 be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of  
9 the sick leave bank as determined by the trial court of the commonwealth.
