In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to naturalization proceedings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 18 of chapter 220 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 1, the word "may" and replacing it
- 3 with the word "shall".
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 18 of chapter 220 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 5 further amended by striking out, in line 3, the words "at such times as the court by general order
- 6 may direct" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- to assist in naturalizing aliens
- 7 resident within their respective judicial districts pursuant to section 15 of this chapter.
