An Act providing for the enforcement of child abuse reporting requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 119 § 51A of the 2014 Official Edition of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended in line 46 by striking out the words “one thousand dollars” and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following words: “twenty-five thousand dollars or by imprisonment in the  
4 House of Corrections for not more than two and one half years, or both such fine and  
5 imprisonment.”

6           SECTION 2. Chapter 119 § 51A of the General Laws is hereby amended in line 48 by  
7 striking out the words “one thousand dollars” and inserting in place thereof the following words:  
8 “twenty-five thousand dollars or by imprisonment in the House of Corrections for not more than  
9 two and one half years, or both such fine and imprisonment.”
