Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 262 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3, the number " $\$ 40$ " and inserting in its place the following:- " $\$ 50$ "

SECTION 2. Said section 24 of said chapter 262, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 9 , the number " $\$ 50$ " and inserting in its place the following:"\$60"
