*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 53 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by  
2   inserting in subsection (b) after the figure “\$150” the following: or not more than thirty days in a  
3   jail or house of correction.
