An Act relative to larceny.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1: Section 30, Chapter 266 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 8, 12, 73, and 77 the words “two
- 3 hundred and fifty dollars” and replacing it with “one thousand five hundred dollars”.
