Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8A of chapter 278 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012

- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following paragraph:-
- 3 If a person using this defense is found not guilty by a court of competent jurisdiction, said
- 4 person shall not be liable in civil proceedings for the injury or death of the person unlawfully in
- 5 said dwelling.
