**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to sex selection in pregnancy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1.

2 Section 12L of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official
3 Edition of the General Laws of Massachusetts, is hereby amended by striking the period at the
4 end thereof and adding the following:— “provided, however, no physician shall intentionally
5 perform such an abortion with the knowledge that the mother is seeking the abortion solely on
6 account of the sex of the unborn child.”

7 SECTION 2.

8 Section 12M of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official
9 Edition of the General Laws of Massachusetts, is hereby amended by striking the period at the

10 end thereof and adding the following:— “provided, however, no physician shall intentionally
11 perform such an abortion with the knowledge that the mother is seeking the abortion solely on
12 account of the sex of the unborn child.”
