*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 188 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting in line 78 after the word “common” the following:-
- 3 , persons who hold a remainder interest in the realty,
