An Act relative to senior property tax exemptions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1 Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 adding at the end thereof, the following new subsection:-

3 Fifty-Eight Upon the acceptance of this subsection by a city or town, a resident of the
4 commonwealth residing in said city or town who reaches the age of 75 shall be exempt from real
5 property taxes on that percentage of said funds which are devoted to local education purposes.
