Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Chapter 151 of the General Laws, section 1A, is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out paragraph number (20), as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following subsection:-
- 4 (20) in an amusement park of a permanent or traveling nature, containing an aggregation
- of amusement devices, games, shows, and other attractions, licensed pursuant to Chapter 140,
- 6 Section 205A, and operated for public use, recreation or amusement during a period, or
- 7 accumulated periods, not in excess of one hundred eighty days in any one year.
