Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a certain parcel of land
2 located on Border street in the East Boston section of the city of Boston shall not be included
3 within the boundaries of any designated port area. This parcel, located at 266-68 Border street in
4 the East Boston section of the city of Boston, is more particularly described in and registered
5 under certificate of title number 128950 in the Suffolk county registry of deeds.
