Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 12 of chapter 156C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-
- 3 (e) Notwithstanding subsection (d), for a limited liability company that has been certified
- 4 by the supplier diversity office pursuant to section 61 of chapter 7 as a veteran business
- 5 enterprise, minority business enterprise or women business enterprise as defined in section 58 of
- 6 said chapter 7, the fee for the filing of the certificate of organization required by subsection (a)
- shall be \$250, and the fee for the filing of the annual report required by subsection (c) shall be
- 8 \$250.
