#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to workers' compensation coverage for officers of non-profit associations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Subsection (4) of section 1 of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the fifth paragraph the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- 4 This chapter shall be elective for an officer of a non-profit entity or corporation, as
- 5 defined by the Internal Revenue Code, who is not compensated. Notwithstanding Section 46,
- 6 these provisions shall apply only if the corporate officer provides the director of industrial
- 7 accidents with a written waiver of his rights under this chapter. Said director shall promulgate
- 8 regulations to carry out the purpose of this paragraph. Violations of this paragraph shall subject
- 9 the non-profit corporation to the penalties set forth in Section 25C.
