In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to veterans' work-related experience in applying for certain licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting the following new section:-
- 3 Section 26. Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary, veterans
- 4 who reside in the Commonwealth may be exempted from apprenticeship, school and other
- 5 requirements to acquire a permit or license to perform work in an area requiring a license. The
- 6 commissioner shall promulgate rules and regulations to award veterans exemption from
- 7 requirements or credits towards licensure for all related military experience and schooling in the
- 8 area in which the veteran seeks to be licensed. The rules and regulations shall include, but not be
- 9 limited to, accepting military training and work experience in lieu of apprenticeship fully or
- partially, as the licensing authority determines, and exempting the veteran from apprenticeship
- 11 and other requirements.
