An Act relative to motor vehicle warranties.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 93B of the general laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following subsection at the end thereof:-

3           “(k) An insurer shall not dictate the use of a part that compromises the operational safety  
4 or structural integrity of the vehicle. No insurer shall mandate non-OEM parts on any vehicle  
5 still under manufacturer warranty or lease agreement.”
