An Act reaffirming our commitment to serving adults with autism.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Section 2 of Chapter 123B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking, in line 16, the following words:- "and subject to  
3   appropriation".
