An Act relative to local review for public structures.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 40A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting after the words "building coverage  
3 requirements;" in lines 51-52, the following words:-

4           and provided further, that said land or structures, if used for educational purposes on land  
5 owned or leased by the commonwealth or any of its agencies, subdivisions or bodies politic,  
6 shall be subject to a review by the appropriate zoning authority of the host community  
7 concerning the bulk and height of structures and determining yard sizes, lot area, setbacks, open  
8 space, parking and building coverage requirements. Said review shall include but not be limited  
9 to a public hearing before the appropriate zoning authority and an opportunity for written public  
10 comment.
