An Act relative to mobile spas.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the
2 following section:-

3 SECTION 264: Any registered aesthetician, cosmetologist, hairdresser, manicurist or
4 operator shall be granted a temporary one day license by the Board to practice in a non-mobile
5 facility other than a registered shop, including but not limited to, private residences. Licensees
6 shall provide the board with prior notice, in an amount to be determined by the board, of the
7 location, time, and nature of services to be provided, and any other information the Board may
8 require. Licensees shall present their licenses to the customer upon request. Licensees may
9 perform only those services the Board deems safe to perform outside a registered shop. The

- 10 Board may, prior to the commencement of the appointment, inspect the licensees' equipment for
- 11 sanitation and safety, but may not enter the premises without permission.
