An Act relative to victim witness advocate retirement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: Group 2 of paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the  
2   General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 139 of the acts of 2012, is hereby further  
3   amended by inserting after the words “assistant district attorneys who have been employed in  
4   such capacity for ten years or more;” the following words:- employees holding the title of victim  
5   witness advocate as defined by section 1 of chapter 258B who have been employed in such  
6   capacity for ten years or more;
