An Act relative to the electronic deposit of tax refunds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 85 of chapter 62C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended, in line 3, by inserting after the word “funds.” the following sentence:-

3           “The commissioner shall permit a taxpayer to designate more than one account at  
4 financial institutions for the electronic deposit of such refund or abatement.”
