An Act prohibiting certain termination and cancellation fees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 25C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new section:-

3 Section 9. (a) Subject to federal law and regulation, no provider of telephone, cellular  
4 telephone, television, internet, energy, or water services shall impose a fee for termination or  
5 early cancellation of a service contract in the event the customer has deceased before the end of  
6 such contract.

7 (b) Every violation of this section shall be punishable by a civil penalty not to exceed one  
8 thousand dollars.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
