**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to the licensure of appraisers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 8G of chapter 26 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in the first paragraph, by striking the words “division of
3 insurance” and inserting the following words in place thereof:- ”division of professional
4 licensure”.

5 SECTION 2. Section 8G of chapter 26 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
6 amended, in the first paragraph, by striking the words “commissioner of insurance” and inserting
7 the following words in place thereof:- ”director of the division of professional licensure”.
