## In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court <br> (2017-2018)

An Act relative to land conservation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 38AA of chapter 63 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 44, the figure " $\$ 75,000$ " and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- "\$150,000".

SECTION 2. Section 38AA of chapter 63 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 88 , the figure " $\$ 2,000,000$ " and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- " $\$ 10,000,000$ ".

SECTION 3. Section 6 of chapter 62, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding, in line 817 , after the words "as amended" the following words:- ", or a nonprofit trust in realty organized for the purposes of land conservation established pursuant to chapter 203."

SECTION 4. Said section 6 of chapter 62 , as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 883 , the figure " $\$ 2,000,000$ " and inserting in place thereof the following 9 figure:" $\$ 10,000,000 "$.

SECTION 5. This act shall expire on December 31, 2027.
