Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Subsection (j)(1) of Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out, in line 2, the figure "2018" and inserting in place thereof the following
- 3 figure: "2023"
- 4 SECTION 2. Said subsection (j)(1) of Section 6 of chapter 62 is hereby further amended
- 5 by striking out, in line 6, the figure "2019" and inserting in place thereof the following figure:
- 6 "2024"
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 38Q of chapter 63 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by
- 8 striking out, in line 2, the figure "2018" and inserting in place thereof the following figure:-
- 9 "2023"
- SECTION 4. Said section 38Q of said chapter 63, as so appearing, is hereby further
- amended by striking out, in line 6, the figure "2019" and inserting in place thereof the following
- 12 figure: "2024"
