Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2B of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014

- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 18, after the words "and laws", the
- 3 following:- "; provided further, that, subject to section 4 of chapter 4, for the purposes of this
- 4 section, a farmers' market, as defined by the Massachusetts department of agricultural resources,
- 5 shall be considered a public purpose."
