By Mr. Tarr, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1637) of Bruce E. Tarr for legislation relative to the creation of an employee training tax credit. Revenue.

An Act relative to the creation of a training tax credit.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after subsection (t) the following new subsection:-

3 (u) There shall be a credit for any employer based in Massachusetts who with their own
4 resources including but not limited to training at employer own facilities, payment for training at
5 a third party facility hires individuals for at least two weeks. The credit shall be \$500 for each
6 newly hired full time employee hired in the first three quarters of that fiscal year, not to exceed
7 \$25,000 per business in any calendar year.

8 SECTION 2. SECTION 1 shall expire on July 1, 2020.
