An Act relative to structural steel.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 44F of chapter 149 of General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official  
2   Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 13, the words “and (s)” and inserting in place  
3   thereof the following words: (s) structural steel including when applicable structural steel  
4   framing, shear connectors, steel or metal joists, steel or metal decking, and/or hot dipped metal  
5   galvanizing; and (t).
