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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)  
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An Act reducing the costs for small businesses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 156C of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking subsection (d), as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof  
3 the following section:-

4           (d) The fee for filing of the certificate of organization required by subsection (a) shall be  
5 two hundred and fifty dollars. The fee for the filing of the annual report required by subsection  
6 (c) shall be two hundred and fifty dollars. Such fee shall be paid to the state secretary at the time  
7 the annual report is filed.

8           SECTION 2. Section 1 shall be effective beginning January 1, 2019.
