The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)

An Act creating Lysosomal Storage Disorders awareness month.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15BBBBBB,
2 as appearing in chapter 267 of the acts of 2016, the following section:-

3 Section 15CCCCCC. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the
4 month of July as Lysosomal Storage Disorders Awareness Month, to increase awareness and
5 understanding of the 6 diseases that can cause peripheral nervous system damage and deaths in
6 infants and young children. Lysosomal Storage Disorders are rare inherited diseases which can
7 be less debilitating if screened for and detected early in newborn children.
