An Act to reduce energy burdens and increase competitiveness in the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of section 10 of chapter 25A of the General Laws, as so  
2 appearing, is hereby amended by striking out clause “(6)” and by inserting before “(5)” the  
3 following word:- “and”

4 SECTION 2. The first sentence of subsection (o) of section 94 of chapter 143 of the  
5 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out all words after the phrase  
6 “state building code”

7 SECTION 3. Section 98 of said chapter 143, as so appearing, is hereby amended by  
8 inserting after the first sentence the following new sentence:-

9           Such restrictive standards cannot apply to those provisions of the state building code that  
10 are based upon the International Energy Conservation Code.
